

CASE OF DEMEO PINOT NOIR

A lovely crimson color, with a splash of maroon. Spicy raspberry, white truffle, grilled thyme, and an interesting sour melon nuance. An entry of almost exotic Pinot fruit, which then leads to a long, well-strewn finish, with elastic and microfiber tannins. A prudent display of tension; the palate that glides - overall. A true head-turner.

UPDATED AUCTION ITEM:

CASE OF TAFT STREET CHARDONNAY

With a bright nose of pear and lemon, this Chardonnay highlights fruit-forward flavors of honeysuckle and apple. The French Oak and partial malolactic fermentation add a delightfully creamy combination of toasted almond and creme brulee. The result is a bright, fruit-forward wine with a long enjoyable finish. Sourced from six local, well known Russian River Valley vineyards for this wine: Clone 17 from Saralee Kundee's Catie's Corner; Clone 4 & 809 from Hopkins Vineyards; Clone 4 & 17 from Vino Farms' Airport Vineyard and Art Ibleto's Bella Sonoma vineyard, and the Robert Young Clone from Dutton Ranch and Nonella Vineyards. 80% of the Chardonnay was barrel fermented in Damy French oak barrels. The wine was aged ten months Sur Lie and 30% of the barrel fermented wine underwent malolactic fermentation.

2013 SILENT HILLS VINEYARD CABERNET SAUVIGNON, 2 BOTTLES

A warm spring brought early bud break, and helped with canopy vigor and berry size creating ideal conditions for flowering and fruit set. Temperatures were consistent for optimal vine activity, resulting in healthy vines as fruit went through veraison and started ripening. Fruit was harvested on September 15th at 23.8 Brix with a pH of 3.8. The ferment began after a 4 day cold soak, finished in 6 days, and pressed upon taste which resulted in a 3 day extended maceration. Aged for 18 months in French oak, the wine opens with aromatics of spicy red fruits followed by juicy textured stone fruits throughout the finish. Drink now through 2021.
